



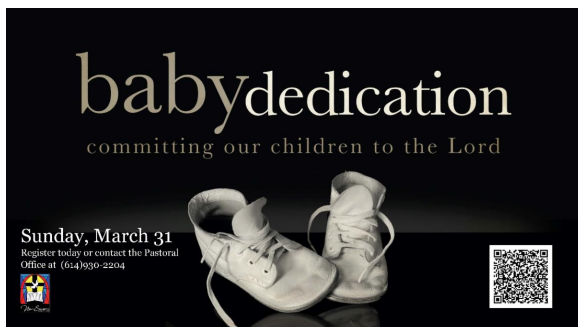

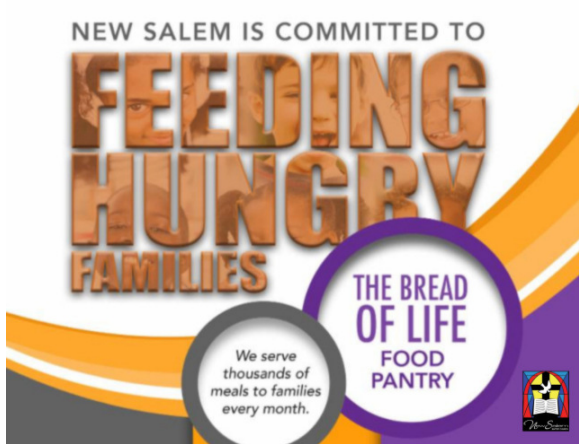

over 1000 coats were purchased or given off the very backs of generous church members and guests. We knew 'something good' had happened in that worship experience that only God could orchestrate. Days later, Pastor reported back to us the good fruit of that coat collection campaign; so much so that other church leaders were inspired to do the same.

Your Awesome Kidneys: Quiet Powerhouses Keeping You Healthy!

Ever wondered about those two bean-shaped organs near your back? Most people don't think about the kidneys. The kidneys are like superheroes that work quietly to keep you healthy. Take a look at the different roles these fist sized miracles undertake to keep your body functioning properly.

Blood Cleaners: The best known role of the kidneys is to "clean" the blood of waste products. They work nonstop, filtering out waste products your body doesn't need. To get rid of the waste products the kidneys create urine or "pee" to get the waste out of the body.

Water Gatekeepers: The body needs a certain amount of water to function properly. The kidneys help to hold on to water when you haven't had something to drink for a while. They can also get rid of excess water if you are drinking too much. They are the main managers of the water level in the body.

Electrolyte Managers: Your body needs certain minerals called electrolytes to function properly. These electrolytes have to be at a certain level or the body won't function properly and could even completely stop functioning. The kidneys help to regulate the amount of electrolytes in your blood.

Blood Pressure Regulator: Blood pressure is like pressure in a garden hose. The kidneys help to maintain that pressure through a number of complex mechanisms.

Vitamin D Activators: Vitamin D is an important hormone for bones and other structures. Your kidneys take inactive vitamin D and turn it into the active form your body needs.

Red Blood Cell Helpers: Red blood cells carry oxygen to your body. The red blood cells are produced by the bone marrow. The kidneys send a signal (hormone) to the bone marrow to help make more red blood cells when needed.

Acid-Base Balancers: The body has to

maintain a certain acid level for the cells and tissues to operate properly. The kidneys have an important role in maintaining this proper acid level also referred to as pH. So, next time you think about your amazing body, remember your incredible kidneys! They might be small, but they play a huge role in keeping you healthy and functioning at your best.

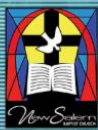
