## Men's Retreat 2024 October 17-19

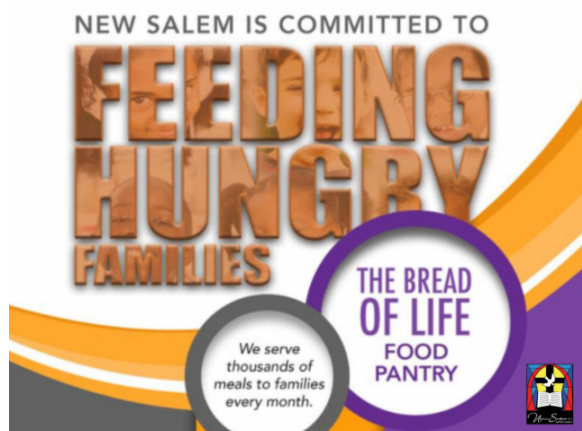
Attention Men of New Salem - Join us this coming October for our Annual Men's Retreat in **Indianapolis, Indiana** from **October 17 - 19**.
