Men's Day is this Sunday our guest preacher will be **Dr. Wayne Davis,** former pastor of Bethel Church Walnut Hills, Cincinnati. Ohio on **Sunday, October 20th** at our 10:00am worship service. Here is more about Dr. Davis:

Rev. Dr. Wayne R. Davis is a native of Cincinnati, OH. He graduated from Walnut Hills High School. He earned his BA Degree from Morehouse College, Atlanta, GA; his Master of Divinity Degree from Colgate Rochester Divinity School, Rochester, NY; his Master of Social Work Degree from the Ohio State University, Columbus, OH; and his Ph.D. Degree in Psychology of Religion with emphasis on Pastoral Psychotherapy from the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, KY.

Dr. Davis served as Senior Pastor of Bethel Baptist Church of Walnut Hills from 1980 to 2019. Turning his flock into informed believers was his quest as he strongly believes that knowledge of the Word of God is imperative to transformed living. He led implementation of training ministries for every age group at Bethel. As a servant-leader, Dr. Davis led Bethel's membership into service.

Dr. Davis used his leadership and teaching gifts to benefit the larger community: He served as Chair of the Affirmative Action Committee, City of Cincinnati; founder of the Cincinnati

One-Church/One Child Committee; Adjunct Professor at Xavier University, Mt. St. Joseph College, and Payne Theological Seminary; Dean of Students at Payne Theological Seminary; Director of the Payne HIV/AIDS Project; and Member of the Golf Advisory Committee, Cincinnati Recreation Commission. He regularly does family and marital counseling. Dr. Davis has rendered significant community service to Cincinnati's young people. He served: on the LSDMC for Spencer Center for Gifted and Exceptional Students; and as an independent-contractor at YouthBuild, a project of the Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency. Dr. Davis and two other community professionals worked with 16 – 24 year old high school drop-outs who learned job skills and obtained their GEDs. Dr. Davis did the psychological assessments, provided group and individual counseling, and cotaught skills that students needed to improve their lives. He loves guiding youth and remarks that 'therapy is a key to reversing a number of the ills plaguing African American males.'

Dr. Davis loves retirement. He is an avid golfer, who is involved in a senior league, but takes time for work that enables the Cincinnati Community. At Corinthian Baptist Church, he serves as head of the Mind Over Matters Counseling Ministry and frequently leads marriage workshops. He is also PTO President at great-granddaughter Nala's elementary school. Dr. Davis is married to Norma Holt Davis, Esq.; the father of one daughter, the grandfather of three and the great grandfather of three.
