



Faith Matters when Feet May Fail

The Sea of Galilee is approximately 141 feet deep. The disciple Peter has a critical faith test when he asks Jesus to invite him to stand on the water. Would Peter focus on the water's width, length, and depth, or would he keep His eyes on The One who could command the Sea to peace or stir at His command? (please read in your quiet time **Matthew 14:22-31, KJV**). Peter began to sink as he no longer focused on Jesus.

Can we relate?

We may judge or even shake our heads at Peter, but the reality is sometimes we, too, sink as we absorb the weight of our trials versus focusing on our God, who can heal and deliver us. We sink because we get overwhelmed and rely on our problem-solving skills instead of keeping our lives in God's hands. God alone can save us from falling! Whether the water's up to our knees or even now at our necks, we can cry out to God, who can restore us! Pastor Troy encouraged us that faith requires us to "get out of the boat" anyway. So, we fix our eyes on Jesus because you've called us to venture out, away from the comforts of the familiar. It's time to go and grow! Now that we've placed a foot out of the boat, our faith growing, you reach your hand out, Lord, for us to grab ahold of. You will not let us sink. We're walking away from the comfort of our hometown, our old friends, and our comfortable jobs. PRAYER: Lord, like Peter, we note that the wind and elements are boisterous. But Lord, if you've called us to you, let us obediently and bravely walk to you. It's time! **AMEN.**
