Recap of McClain-Walters The Deborah Anointing



Prayer Watch Does God Always Answer Prayer?

The word of God provides us with a guide for prayer; what to pray, when to pray and how to pray. We are encouraged to come boldly to God and approach Him with confidence (Hebrews 4:16). We need not address Him in a sheepish manner nor be timid and apprehensive. We can and should pray about everything. Philippians 4:6 says we are to "in every situation by prayer and petition with thanksgiving make our requests known to God." We are instructed and encouraged to pray without ceasing, rather than every so often. We serve a loving God who only wants the best for us and is always available to us. But admittedly, there are times when we wonder if He heard our cry when he seeming has not answered us. This begs the question: does God always answer prayer?

I can say without fear of contradiction that God does indeed always answer our prayer. He's always listening as Psalms 34:15 tells us "the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry." He's always listening and He always answers. Here are some of His answers: Yes. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son (John 14:13). No. When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures (James 4:3). Not yet. You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised (Hebrews 10:36).

To align with the will of God should be our heart's desire. We should want Him and His plan more than anything. So, what do we do when the answer to our prayer is not an immediate "yes"? Keep praying, keep asking, keep seeking Him. Perhaps not so much for the "thing" but for Him. Develop a close and intimate relationship with Him so that you want Him more than anything or anyone else.
