



Nurses' Ministry: Provides care for worshippers in need of physical assistance and supports the Pastor and guests.







Addressing Literacy in Linden: A Call to Action

Addressing Literacy in Linden: A Call to Action By: Deacon Tracy Robinson

Dear New Salem Church Family,

Did you know that many children in our community are struggling with reading? In four Linden elementary schools, literacy rates remain a critical challenge—but through the power of faith, service, and partnership, we are making a

difference. Only 35% of Linden third graders are reading up to speed.

For the past two years, the New Salem Fatherhood Ministry, led by Deacon Tracy Robinson, has been actively engaged in supporting these schools. Alongside dedicated members Deacon Lawrence Brown, Deacon Randy Marshall, Donald Waytes, and Fred Jones, the ministry has hosted Dads with Doughnuts events, encouraging fathers to read with their children for just 20 minutes a day to strengthen their reading skills. The response has been overwhelming; over 400 fathers have stepped up to the challenge, with events so well-attended that we've run out of coffee and doughnuts every time!

But the work doesn't stop there.

New Salem Missionary Baptist Church, in partnership with Nationwide Children's Hospital, is proud to sponsor the Linden Readathon—a community-wide effort to:

- Raise awareness about the importance of early literacy.
- Connect families with free resources like the Columbus Metropolitan Library Summer Reading Program and the Dolly Parton Imagination Library (which sends a free book every month to any registered child!).
- Provide a day of fun, food, and prizes while promoting the love of reading.
