How to Become a Prayer Warrior

Are you a Prayer Warrior or Prayer Worrier? Only two letters separate these words but there is a significant difference between them. One definition for Prayer Warrior is: anyone who is committed to praying for others. God wants us to pray for others. We know this from the Word of God and the numerous scriptures that call us to pray for one another. "...bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." Luke 6:28 NIV

"I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone – for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness." I Timothy 2: 1-2 NIV

"Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective." James 5:16 NIV

So, how do you become a prayer warrior? I suggest five steps to take.

1. Ask God to help you. Of all the requests the disciples asked Jesus while they were with him; the one that stands out to me is found in Luke 11:1 NIV: "One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples."

2. Make a habit of reading and studying the Bible. Second Timothy 2:15 KJV tells us to "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

3. Make a habit of praying continually. The Apostle Paul says that we should "...rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer..." Romans 12:12 KJV

4. Just do it! There's no better time to start praying than now. Start praying during your quiet time with just you and God. Pray when you wake up in the morning and when you lie down at night. And, if you don't know what to pray for, there is no better prayer to pray than the Lord's Prayer:

"Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen." Matthew 6: 9-13 KJV

5. Join the Prayer Ministry. Calls are held Monday – Friday, at 6:00 a.m., 12 noon, and 6:00 p.m. All are welcome! These calls offer a safe and welcoming space to pray and worship. Becoming a Prayer Warrior will take time, practice, and the Holy Spirit's help to learn how to make praying for others a priority. The blessing is, Prayer Warrior cancels out Prayer Worrier!

BECOME A FOSTER PARENT

Founded in 2005, Caregiver's Helper, Inc. is a private, non-profit, treatment foster care agency serving Central Ohio and surrounding areas.

roster care agency serving Central Ohio and surrounding areas. **Caregive's** Helper serves children of all backgrounds from birth to 18 years of age, or 21 years of age if diagnosed with a developmental disability. Providing protection and permanency for children is our top priority, as there are always children in need of a healthy, nurturing, and lowing home. However, providing support and assistance to foster parents is of equal importance to the agency, which is how it earned the name of Caregiver's Helper. By having a close-knit taum of skillful, professional, and caring individuals the agency continues to build strong relationships with families and within the community.

To become a foster parent, an applicant must be at least 21 years of age; have additional bedrooms or bed space; complete the application and 24 hours of state required training: passes a background check; and have sufficient income to meet basic household expenses. Applicants can be married, single, widowed, divorced, of have children of their own. Monthly reimbursement is provided to foster parents to ensure that children in their care have all their basic needs met.
