



Back-to-School Health Checklist for Families By: Dr. Christopher Brown, MD, MPH, FACP, FASN

The new school year is here! Beyond pencils and notebooks, let's equip our children with healthy habits that support their learning and growth. Here are some of the the top essentials:

- 1. **Vaccinations:** Ensure your child is up to date on school-required immunizations, including boosters.
- 2. **Adequate Sleep:** Children need 9–11 hours of sleep nightly. Rest improves learning, behavior, and immunity.
- 3. **Balanced Meals:** Prepare nutritious breakfasts and lunches with fruits, vegetables, and whole grains to fuel concentration. Avoid sugary snacks that spike energy but hurt focus.
- 4. **Dental Health:** Regular brushing, flossing, and dental check-ups help prevent cavities that can distract from learning.
- 5. **Physical Activity:** Encourage at least 60 minutes of active play daily to strengthen bodies and minds.
- 6. Handwashing: Reinforce good hygiene to prevent the spread of colds and flu.
- 7. **Screen Time:** Limit non-school screen time to 1–2 hours a day. Excess screen use affects sleep and academic focus.
- 8. **Mental Health:** Check in with your child emotionally; adjusting to new routines can be stressful.
- 9. **Eye Health:** Back-to-school is a great time for vision checks, which can detect poor vision which can be an impediment to learning.

Healthy habits not only protect our children but also set them on a path for lifelong well-being. As Proverbs 22:6 reminds us, "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it."
