

#### "Don't Let Silence Drown Us" By: Dr. Chris Brown, MD, MPH, FACP

Drowning doesn't look like what we see in the movies. It's fast. Silent. Often fatal. Recently, the tragic death of actor Malcolm-Jamal Warner brought national attention to water safety. But this is not a new crisis—especially in our community. Black children are more than five times more likely to drown in swimming pools than white children. Black

men are at even greater risk around lakes, rivers, and oceans. We must act.

#### Here's how:

- Enroll in swim lessons. They reduce drowning risk by 88% in children. Adults can learn too.
- Watch the water. Stay alert. Put your phone down.
- Wear life jackets when boating or fishing.
- Learn CPR. It could mean life or death.

Our children deserve to splash in the water safely. Our elders deserve to fish and boat safely. And we must equip ourselves with the tools to protect them. This is not just about swimming. It's about survival.




