## Prostate Cancer Awareness: A Call to Faith and Health

September is **Prostate Cancer Awareness Month**, a time to lift up the importance of protecting men's health within our families and our faith community. Prostate cancer is one of the most common cancers among men, and while it can often be treated successfully when detected early, it remains a leading cause of cancer-related death. For men over the age of 40, African American men, and those with a family history of prostate cancer, the risks are even greater. One of the best tools we have is the Prostate-Specific Antigen (PSA) test, a simple blood test that can detect early signs of cancer before symptoms develop. We believe that honoring our bodies is part of honoring God. Caring for our health allows us to remain strong servants in our families, our church, and our community. Encouraging our brothers, fathers, and sons to take charge of their health is an act of both love and faith. Call to Action: If you are a man over 40—or if you have a family history of prostate cancer—I urge you to talk with your primary care provider about a PSA test. 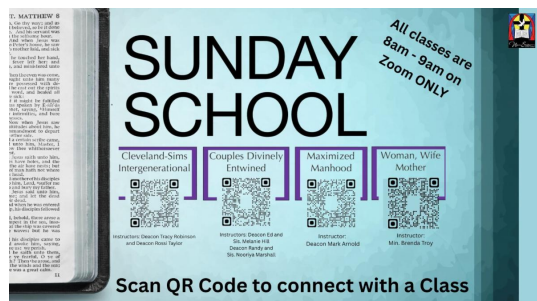
