Intercessory Prayer When You Care Enough to Give Your Very Best

If you've ever received a greeting card in the mail, you remember how it felt. Just knowing that someone took the time to send you a card felt good because you knew the sender was thinking about you, even if just for the time it took to purchase, sign, and mail the card. Think of intercessory prayer as sending someone a spiritual greeting card, only 100 times better.

Hallmark has a commercial that encourages viewers to send one of their cards "when you care enough to send the very best!" Intercessory prayer is one of the highest ways that we can care for one another.

Intercessory prayer is the act of praying to God on behalf of another person or group. It involves lifting up the needs, concerns, and situations of others to God, acting as a mediator or standing "in the gap" between them and the Divine.

Intercessory Prayer is:

An active process of mediating, pleading, and petitioning God on behalf of others, including loved ones, strangers, governments, and nations.

An unselfish act rooted in compassion and love for others. When you pray about others concerns and needs, you aren't thinking about yourself.

A spiritual habit that connects you more closely to God and others.

A double blessing because it blesses both the sender (the one who prays) and the one who receives. And God gets the glory!

Examples of Intercessory Prayer in the Bible:

Job 42:10 NLT (Job prayed for his friends)

"When Job prayed for his friends, the Lord restored his fortunes. In fact, the Lord gave him twice as much as before."

Luke 23:34a NLT (Jesus prays for his persecutors)

Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they don't know what they are doing."

Romans 8:26-27 NLT (The Holy Spirit intercedes for us)

"And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. And the Father who knows all hearts knows what the Spirit is saying, for the Spirit pleads for us believers in harmony with God's own will."


